In pursuit of this goal, whilst recognising all human activities contribute to global pollution, we are committed to the principle of prevention of pollution resulting directly and indirectly from our work activities.

Our intention of continual reduction and prevention of pollution will be achieved by the following:

- 1 Compliance with all legislation
- 2 Raising the environmental awareness of all our employees through regular training and instruction
- 3 Through senior management commitment and the commitment of sufficient resources
- 4 Minimising, wherever possible, our consumption of energy and raw materials
- 5 Recycling wherever practicable
- 6 Continually reviewing of our environmental aspects and impacts
- 7 Managing and minimising our use of consumables
- 8 Management of our activities to avoid unnecessary or unacceptable risks to all our employees, customers and members of the public and environment

We will conduct our operations through a set of control procedures found in the Environmental Procedures Manual relating to:

- 1 Transport (Fuel Consumption)
- 2 Hire equipment (Emissions) (Noise)
- 3 Utility Consumption (Electricity, gas, water)
- 4 Waste Oils
- 5 Hazardous Waste (Oil filters, rags, cleaning clothes, chemicals)
- 6) Waste water (Test well water, wash water, domestic water)
- 7 Waste batteries (Disposal)
